Organized by the **USC ANNENBERG SCHOOL FOR COMMUNICATION**, *Black on Black* revisits the Emmy Award-winning documentary by journalism professor **JOE SALTZMAN** 40 years after its premiere. The film examined the devastating aftermath of the riots in South Los Angeles in the mid-1960s. Following a screening of his film, Saltzman joins University Professor **GEOFFREY COWAN**, communication professor **FÉLIX GUTIÉRREZ**, and USC Vice Provost **MICHAEL PRESTON** for a panel discussion that explores how conditions have changed for African Americans in Los Angeles in the last 40 years.
