### About Ángel Corella and the Corella Ballet

Born in Madrid in 1975, Ángel Corella won honors in Spain and Paris as a dancer at a young age. He joined the American Ballet Theatre in 1995 and has been a principal dancer there for the past fifteen years He formed the Corella Ballet Castilla y León in 2008. Currently the only ballet company in Spain, Corella Ballet incorporates classical and contemporary choreography. Composed of 33 dancers representing ten countries, Corella's dynamic company brings its inimitable style and energy to Los Angeles for the first time.

At this performance the audience will experience *Soleá* choreographed by famous flamenco dancer and choreographer María Pagés and performed by Ángel and Carmen Corella, *DGV* by the prolific Christopher Wheeldon, *Bruch Violín Concerto Nº 1* by the awardwinning Clark Tippet, and *Clear* by the gifted Stanton Welch.

A term derived from the Latin *ballare*, which means "to dance", ballet as a movement art form began in the 1400s. Classical ballet specifically focuses on the delicate and precises movements of dancers following formalized techniques.

Ballet dancers train through one of eight forms of classical ballet technique, including Vaganova (Russian), Cecchetti (Italian), Royal Ballet School, and Balanchine (American) technique.


