USC students will see the Los Angeles premiere of Michael Golamco's acclaimed play *Cowboy Versus Samurai*. In this comic reimagining of *Cyrano de Bergerac*, Travis Park is a high-school English teacher and the only Korean American living in the dusty town of Breakneck, Wyoming. When Veronica Lee, a Korean American teacher from New York City, moves into town, he immediately falls for her. Travis must choose between the Asian and the American within himself as he pursues a love that may be only as real as the love letters he writes for someone else. Through irony, humor and social commentary, *Cowboy Versus Samurai* cleverly exposes the struggle of Asian Americans to find their place in the vast American landscape...and with each other.
