Information Literacy Instruction Librarian (# 370)

Responsibilities and Duties

Reporting to the Head, Information Literacy, the Information Literacy Instruction Librarian will:

- Deliver information literacy instruction, including instruction related to primary sources and other areas of literacy, in a variety of formats, synchronous and asynchronous
- Participate in the development of information literacy instruction programs
- Advance the instruction program's commitment to learner-centered pedagogy, inclusive learning environments, and equity of student experience
- Participate in all reference and information services, including reference consultations, chat reference service, and assist users in developing search strategies
- Work collaboratively with faculty and staff (in the libraries and instructors in other schools) on initiatives to strengthen students' transferable skills and abilities in information literacy and critical thinking
- Contribute to reporting and assessment programs as necessary
- Participate in meetings, committees, and other communities of practice related to teaching, pedagogy, learning theory, etc.
- Engage in professional organizations, research, or publishing that will have a significant, positive impact on the USC Libraries strategic plan, and advance the University's strategic plan and vision
- Duties may include weekend and evening hours
- Other duties as assigned.

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
