

Undergraduate Summer Scholarships

Chapter 036, University of Southern California

Chapter 036 of Phi Kappa Phi at the University of Southern California invites students to apply for a scholarship to support research or creative projects during the summer of 2024.

Award amount: Up to \$1,000.

Eligibility: Any student who is a sophomore or junior at the University of Southern California during the Spring 2024 semester and has a minimum 3.25 cumulative grade point average is eligible to apply. Students graduating in the summer are ineligible.

Materials to Submit

Applicants must submit the following:

- 1 completed application form (on the following page)
- 1 one-page project proposal
- 1 copy of transcripts for all post-secondary coursework
- 1 letter endorsing the student project from a USC faculty member

Application materials completed by the student should be written in a font no smaller than 10 point, have a title that fits on one line, and be printable on standard US letter-size paper with one inch margins.

Only electronic submissions will be accepted.

The proposal should provide information on the following points: i) The nature of the proposed research project and its significance, and ii) The research plan for the summer, including the specific goals, planned procedure, budget, and timeline.

The student's project cannot be tied to research that is being conducted by a professor (i.e. the student cannot be the professor's assistant on the project).

Deadline: Applications will be accepted through **Friday**, **April 15**, **2024**, **at 5:00 pm**. Application materials may be emailed to pkp@usc.edu. **We will not accept physical submissions**.
