We are looking for candidates with experience in providing information services in an academic or health sciences library setting; experience delivering instruction across multiple literacies, including information and primary source literacy; and a commitment to high quality user experience. Minimum qualifications: A MLIS degree from an ALA-accredited program or non-U.S. equivalent is typically required. Professional library experience or relevant course work and demonstrated experience in one or more of the areas outlined above are required. Desirable qualifications: Knowledge of information literacy in health sciences for the first position listed above and chemistry and chemical engineering for the second position; broad knowledge of information literacy in an academic setting and interest in instruction, including primary source literacy, for the third position. Continuing appointment-track candidates are expected to demonstrate their ability to have a significant positive impact on the development of innovative library and information services as they pertain to the specific position, growth in professional expertise, and professional development.

We value qualified candidates who can bring to our community a diversity of backgrounds and experiences who are motivated by a passion to develop transformative library services and an investment in the future of librarianship and archives, and who are creative in identifying and solving problems within a collegial and collaborative environment.
